Canus Goat's Milk Completes Move to Waterbury, Vermont

Waterbury, Vermont – February 7, 2006 – Canus Goat's Milk of Waitsfield completed the final phase of its planned relocation to new office and warehouse space located in Pilgrim Park in Waterbury, Vermont.

The move, which consolidated all of the company's operations, was completed over the weekend of February 3rd. In December, the company's warehouse and shipping operations had moved to the Waterbury facility from a warehouse located in Berlin, Vermont.

"We're pleased to be the first tenants to locate to the Pilgrim V building" said Andrée Falardeau, President of Canus Goat's Milk, a manufacturer of skin care products based on goat's milk. "Our move to Waterbury will allow us to consolidate all of our operations in a much larger space, generating considerable efficiencies with regard to our operations."

Canus has grown dramatically over the past couple of years due to increased demand for their goat's milk skin care products. "Having the ability to see and touch the orders which are being prepared for some of our larger customers such as Shaw's, Price Chopper or Brook's Drugs is important to maintaining the consistency of our business" she added.

Prior to the move, Canus had occupied approximately 800 square feet of office space in the Irasville Common. The new offices have been scaled significantly larger in order to accommodate planned future growth. "It's hard to believe that we had seven people working out of that small office space!" Canus has 9 employees in the Waterbury location.

"Due to a lot of planning, we were able to make the move into the new space fairly seamlessly, with no interruptions to our customers in terms of ordering or shipping" she said and then added "we're lucky that we have had a great team to work with".

The new facility being constructed at Pilgrim Park contains approximately 42,000 square feet of space. Canus Goat's Milk will occupy around 30% of the facility which will be shared with

Green Mountain Coffee Roasters, Dartmouth Journal Services and Pilgrim Partnership. The building is expected to be completed in April, 2006.

About Canus Goat's Milk

Canus Goat's Milk was founded in Montréal, Canada in the late-nineties by Ms. Falardeau and her business partner, André Beauregard. Canus currently has its U.S. headquarters based in Waterbury, Vermont. The Company markets two complete family skin care lines – Goat's Milk products for adults and Li'l Goat's Milk for children and babies. Canus Goat's Milk products have been recognized by several national industry awards. Andrée Falardeau was named "International Entrepreneur of the Year" by a leading Québec business group in 2002.

Altogether, Canus Goat's Milk produces more than twenty different goat's milk based skin care products that are distributed across North America, in Europe and even in the Philippines. Locally, the products are carried by Mehuron's Supermarket and Sweet Pea Natural Foods in Waitsfield and Vincent's Drug and Variety in Waterbury.

Canus currently employs 35 full time employees and several thousand dairy goats.
